Device Distribution

We currently have a checkout process for students needing chromebooks or mobile hotspot devices. The device is issued to the student by the staff member in charge of chromebooks. We are surveying students to check to see who does not have access to wifi. If a student does not have access to wifi we will provide them with a mobile hotspot device. Most of our students have requested a chromebook to take home, however, we have created a list of those students who do not have a chromebook and are prepared to provide them one. All students are required to follow the CCPS Acceptable Use Policy which can be found on pages 55-57 in the CCPS student handbook.

Delivery of Instruction & Monitoring of Student Learning

The Catoosa Performance Learning Center currently uses the Apex Learning Software as the online instructional delivery model. All students have access to course content, practice, study guides, written work, formative and summative assessments in each online instructional platform. which can be accessed by first logging into their Chromebook, then selecting Apex from the Google apps menu or they can go directly to the site https://www.apexvs.com If parents would like to monitor student progress, they will have to log in under the students account, however, if you can't obtain the password from your child, you may contact Mrs. Vandiver or Ms. Bishop to have the password reset. Currently, assessments are only taken in the classroom, however, we will allow students to take the assessments from home. Teachers will provide pacing guides to students so students will be able to track their own progress of meeting unit deadlines. Teachers will be available during regular class hours for students to ask questions via email. Teachers will monitor student progress and email them when they are not progressing to make sure they do not need help.
